



INTERDISCIPLINARY CROSS-TRAINING PROJECT IN PSYCHOLOGY

for Theologians and Philosophers

WHAT WE OFFER

This program (CTP) is designed to give you an immersive learning experience in a small group of fellow theologians and philosophers that matches your professional needs. Most of the training is online and can easily be integrated in your already busy schedule.

The international team of instructors is led by Prof. Markus Quirin (Psychology, Technical University of Munich) and Prof. Godehard Brüntrup (Philosophical Psychology, Munich School of Philosophy).

The thematic focus will be on personality growth. Topics such as self-realization, autonomy, freedom, openness, self-determination, emotion regulation, integration, authenticity are selected for their interdisciplinary relevance. You will actively engage in conducting an empirical study on personality growth.

Besides two short workshops in Munich at the beginning and at the end, the CTP will take place mostly online. In addition to virtual sessions, there will be multimedia content specifically developed for this project (e-learning platform).

Participants will take part and actively engage in teaching sessions, as well as immersive practices, such as lab visits, and interactive expert talks. In-person workshops enable you to personally connect with each other. We wish to build the foundation for lasting interdisciplinary friendships that will enrich your career.
